 - c) Soldering neatness of PCB.
 - d) Working of the circuit.
 - e) Application of the project.
 - f) Presentation and demonstration of the project.
- **2.** NAME, ADDRESS, E-MAIL ID along with Phone number of the Institute as well as that of the Participants along with the Title of the project must be clearly mentioned on the cover page of the PROJECT REPORT.
- **3.** Report writing should be strictly in IEEE {single column digest format}.
- **4.** One soft copy should be submitted to ELECTROWORKS via E-mail along with Phone number. & E-mail ID of individual participants.
- **5.** After the receipt of REPORT with D.D/CASH & REGISTRATION FORM (duly filled), final conformation will be communicated to the participants of respective Institutes by E-mail as well as on telephone.
- **6.** Project model should be in working condition at the time of exhibition.
- **7.** D.D or CASH of Rs: 300/- per group (non refundable) should be sent in favour of 'ESA-SPIT' payable at Mumbai at any nationalized bank to ELECTROWORKS.
- **8.** Participants should bring their college ID cards along with them.
