



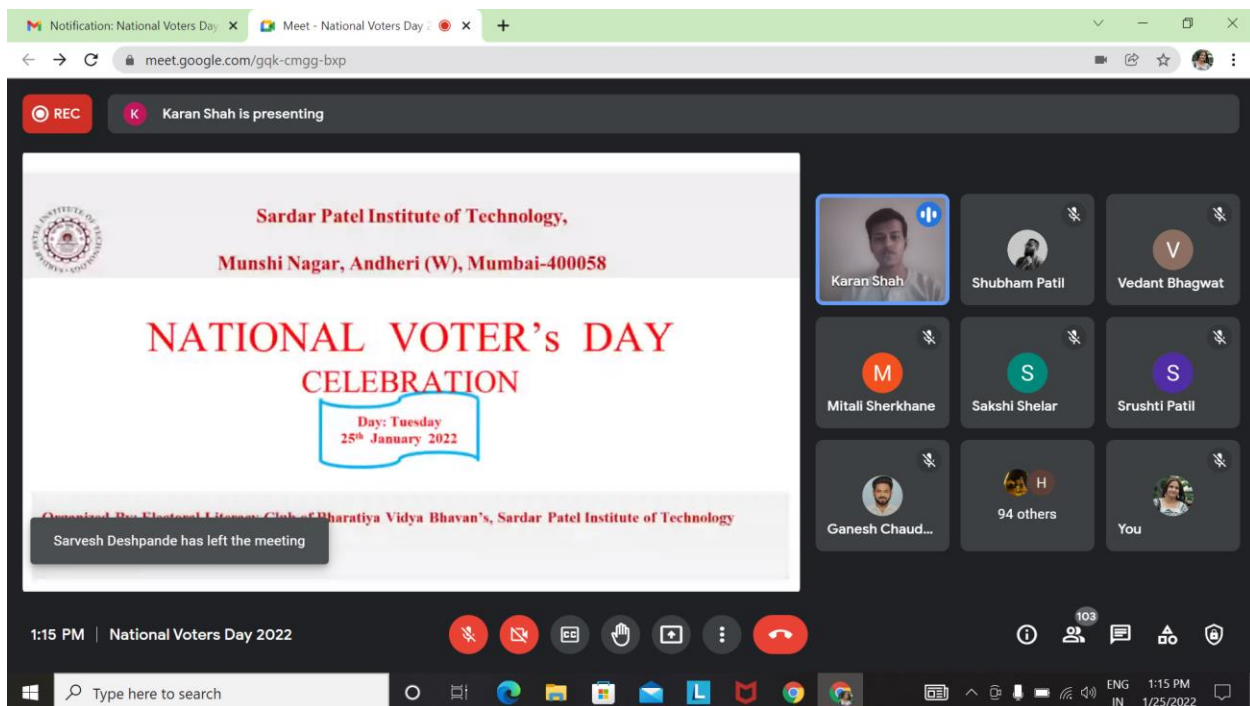

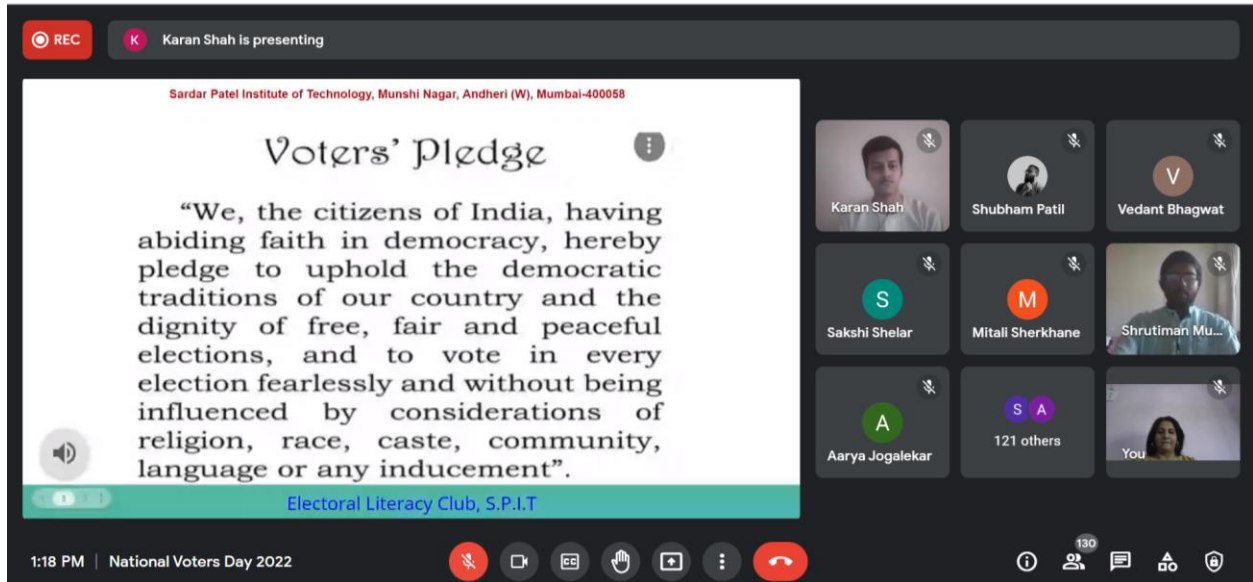
The session commenced with Mr. Karan Shah (SE IT), the student representative of the Electoral Literacy Club, welcoming the audience.



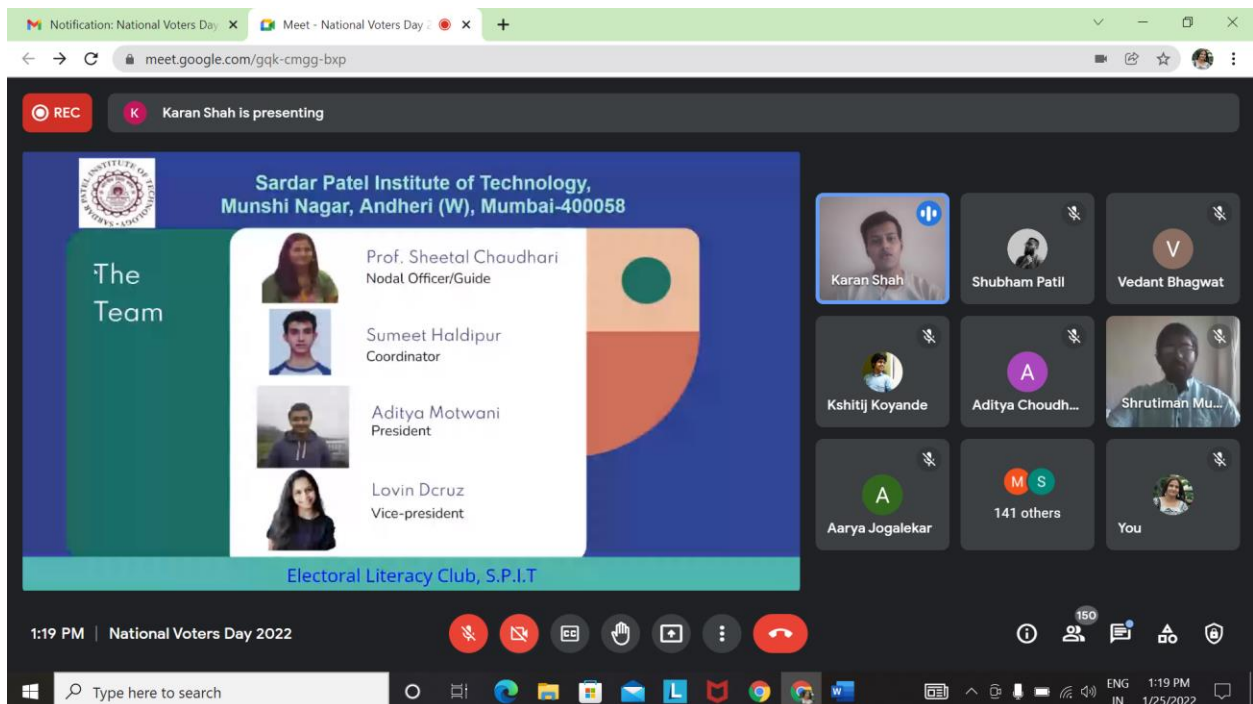

Karan then introduced all the members of the Electoral Literacy Club

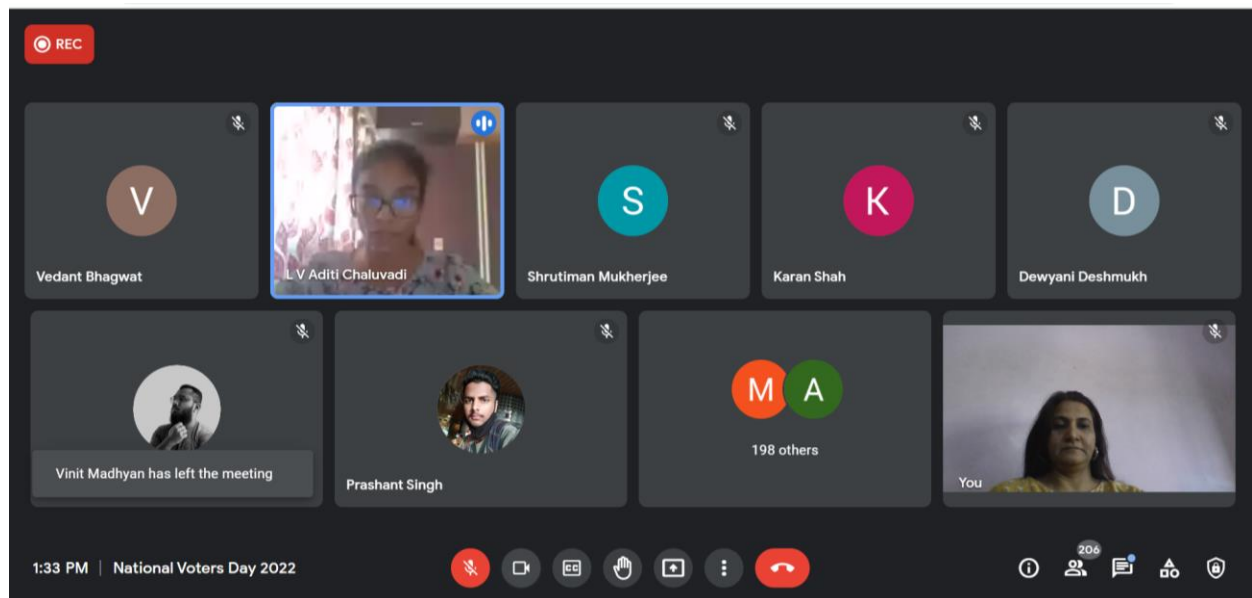

Shrutiman started by casting light on the current situation in India in the domains of availability of basic necessities, education and security and how young voters of the nation are its most valuable asset. He emphasized the impact that an informed and educated voter body can have in the development of the nation by reading some quotes and slogans from prominent persons like Abraham Lincoln and our Honorable Prime Minister, Narendra Modi.
