The Institution has established the Academic Council in order to ensure and analyze the academic excellence at student faculty The institute thoroughly reviews the curriculum for every academic year. The college maintains an IQAC as a quality consistence and quality enhancement measure. Various departments and committees work for Career Guidance, Anti-Ragging and Sexual Harassment Committee, etc. reinforce the curriculum by incorporating suggestions from stakeholders various and experts. 
METHODOLOGY

A google form was designed based on a template developed by the IQAC and circulated among parents of all students belonging to UG as well as PG program. The feedback was divided into different categories like perception, Institute's adherence to its mission statement, Curriculum, Teaching, Learning and Student performance, and Infrastructure and Facilities with few questions under each category. A total of 52 parents responded to the survey with 98% of the responses from the UG category.


FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

Nearly 95% parents also feel that employability is the one of the prime focus areas of S.P.I.T







Feedback was collected from parents on various aspects of our mission statement which is as follows:

- Focus on applied research to create next generation technologies.











Curriculum






Teaching, Learning and Students Performance

Most parents are satisfied with the quality of teaching offered and mentorship and career guidance being provided by S.P.I.T





They have also expressed satisfaction with the information dissemination system of the institute and the unbiased evaluation process.







Parents have rated the various infrastructure parameters of S.P.I.T as follows














Suggestions for improvement
