

The first round commenced with the first 10 PDFs being sent on the Whatsapp group consisting of all the teams. The teams then set out to putting their brains into solving their riddles and the










Unlock yourself in all ways possible such as physically, mentally and emotionally and hence achieve ultimate liberation.


Event Details:-


Judge Biography:-








From painting on a canvas to designing logos to posters and UI/UX designs she has now also expressed herself in the digital world.


Event Details:-



She spoke about how essential women empowerment is and how every woman should be aware of her own rights. Each woman should have a realization of her liberty. She also stressed on the need to read books and gain knowledge, be aware of the current affairs. She advised each one of us to be aware of our surroundings, be sensitive about the unjust happenings and be vocal about the same. She shared her experiences and the lessons she learnt while she was in US and Europe. She realised that the situation of women entrepreneurship was same everywhere. Women are looked down upon when it comes to giving leadership roles. Therefore, it is important for woman to express her opinions, be a leader instead of just being a caretaker. Women should learn to handle social responsibilities judiciously. She also explained how venture capitalists/ government officials are all prominently male dominated domains.



Militariational 2019. The speaker shared her experiences about her personal life and her beauty pageant journey. She




The eloquent speaker guided the participants by giving very useful insights about her life journey:




screens on physical, mental and emotion health. He further recommended eye exercises for good eyesight.
